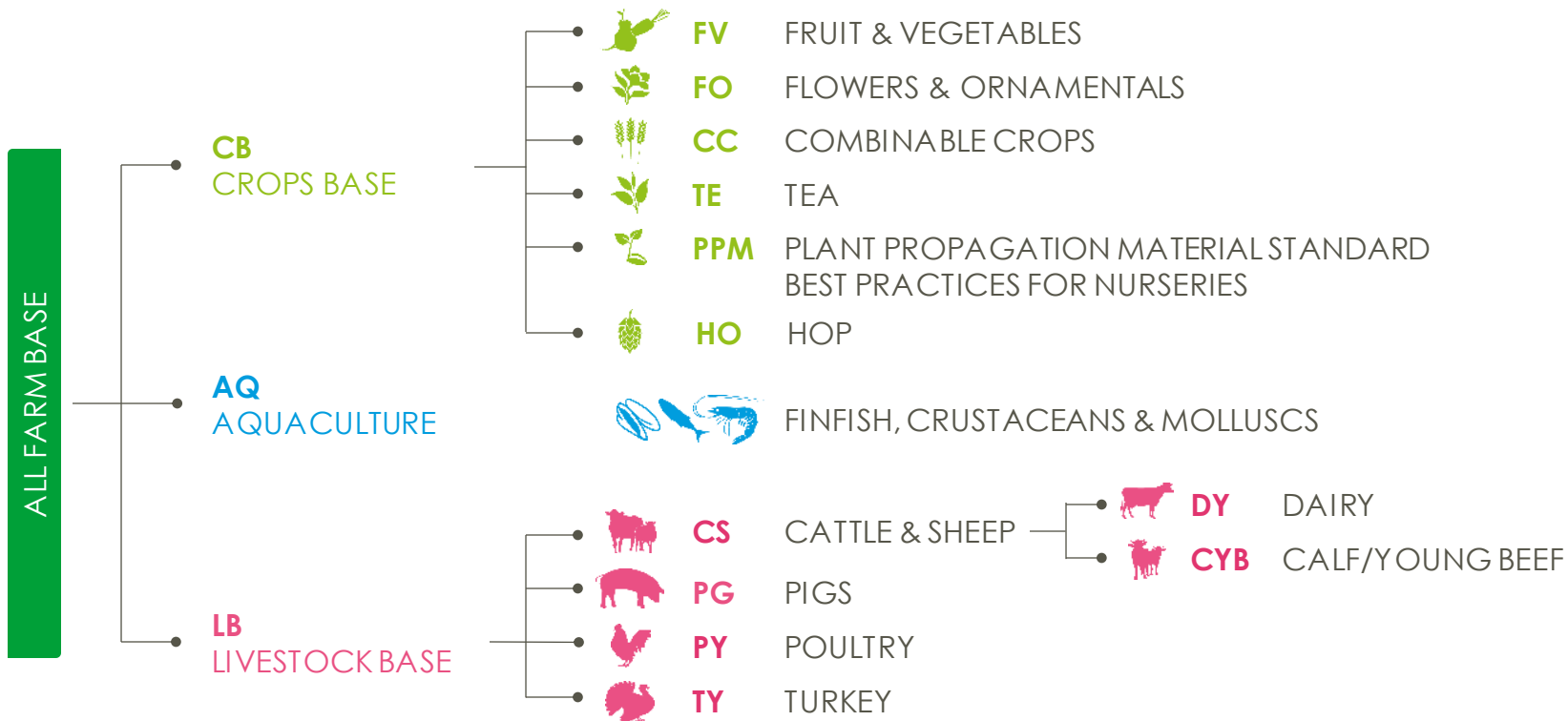

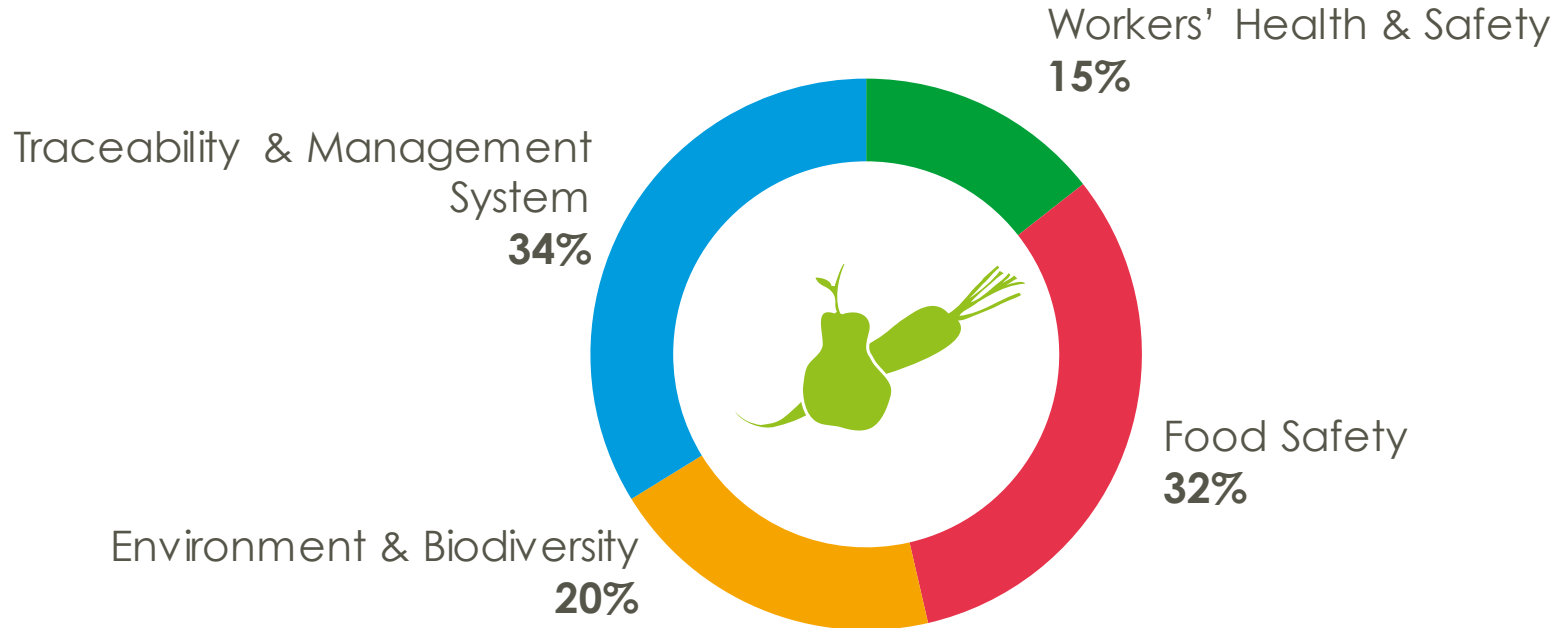

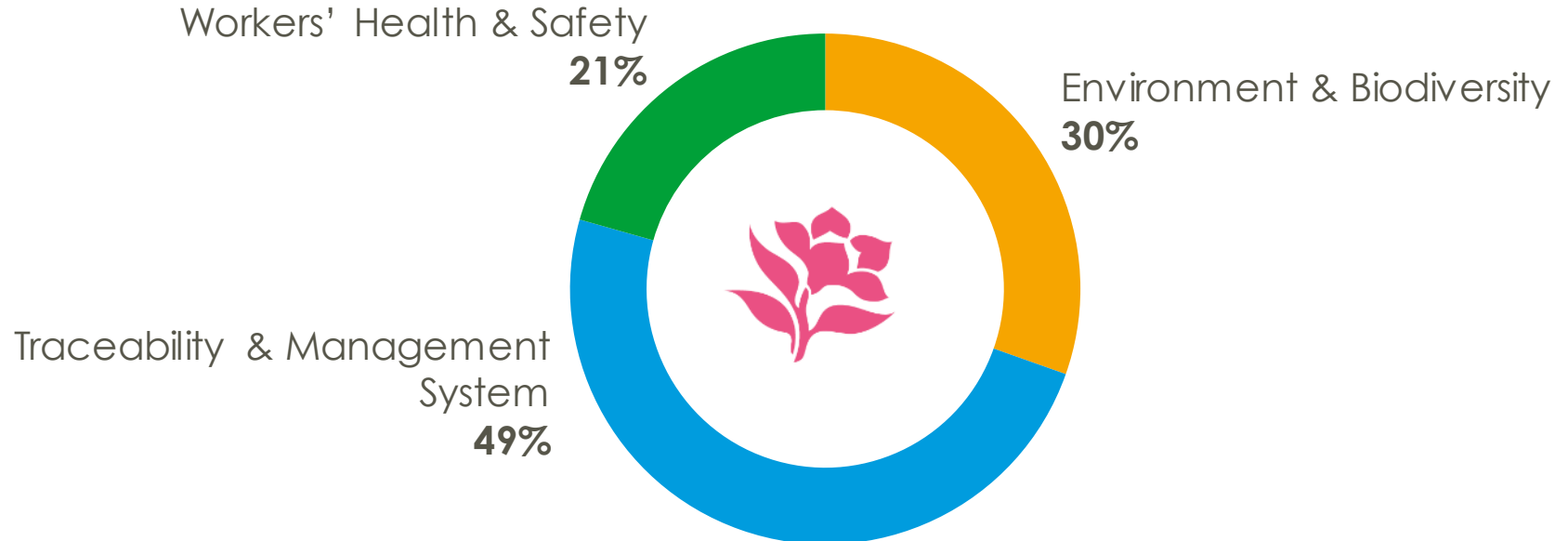

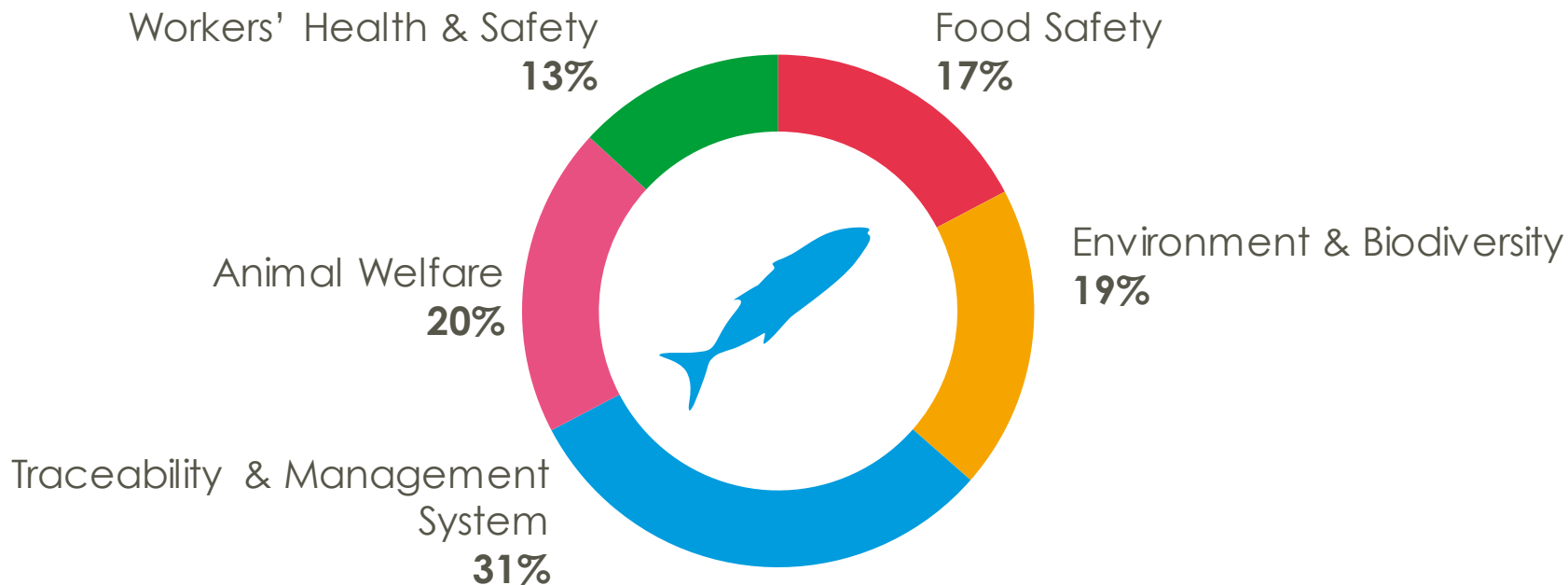

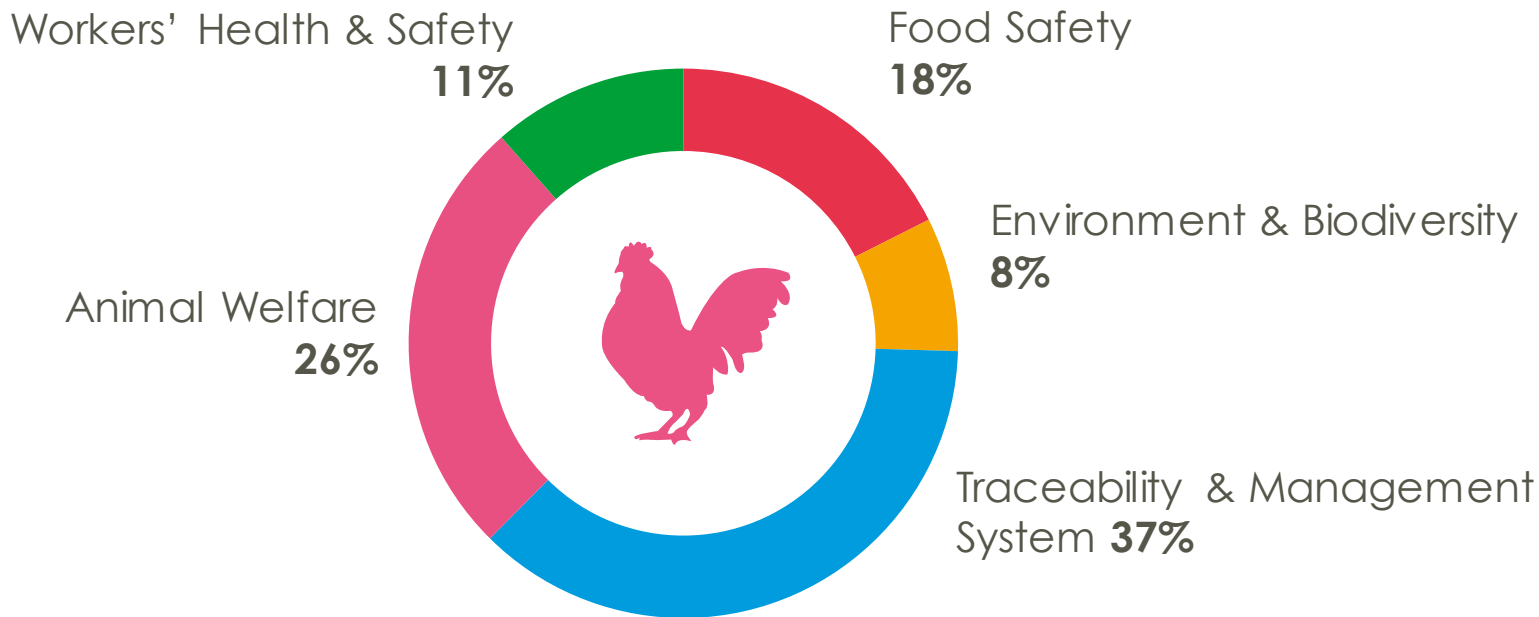

Chain of Custody – Traceability standard

- Objectives of CoC standard are to assure:
- Any product sold as GLOBALG.A.P. certified originates from certified producer/producer group
 - -> Prevention of substitution or dilution with non-certified products
- Segregation and traceability throughout supply chain



- NOT a food safety standard
-
- NO product certification, but process certification

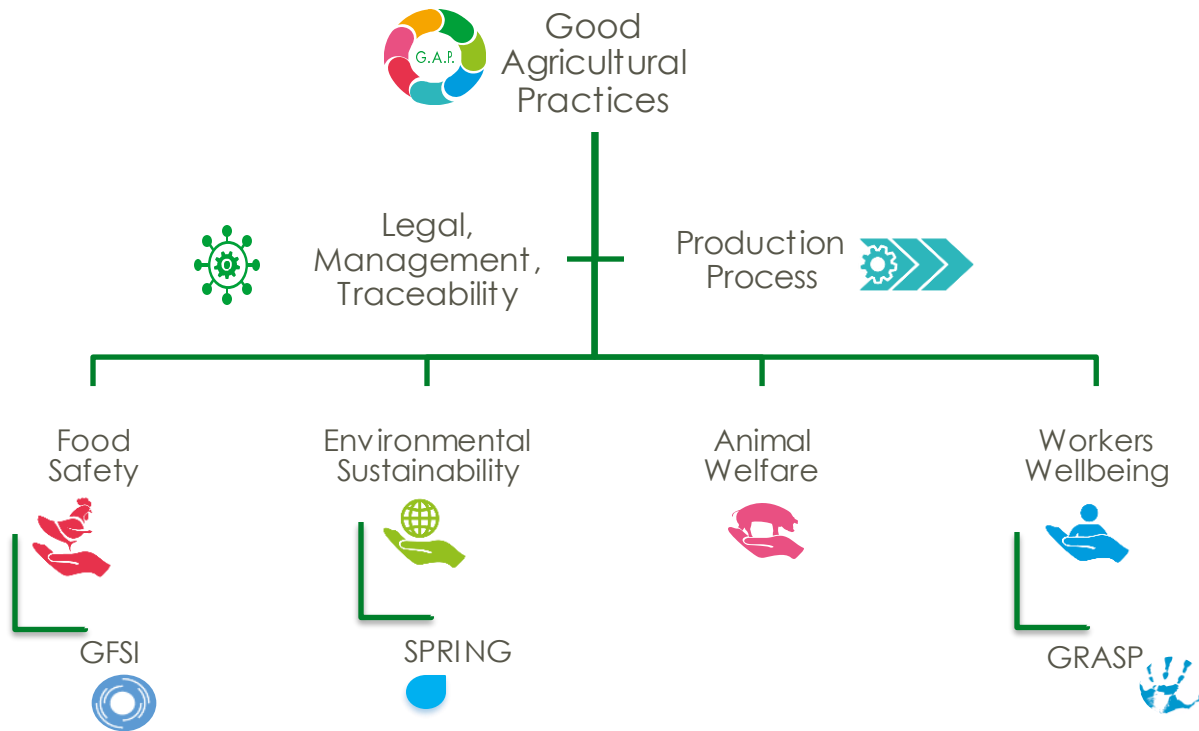


SPRING Criteria:

- **Legal conformity** (water sources, extraction rates)
- **Monitoring** (water consumption)
- **Impact** (sustainable watershed management)
