Directive 2008/120/EC on the protection of pigs

- Article 3(4): MS shall ensure that sows and gilts are kept in groups during a period starting from 4 weeks after the service to 1 week before the expected time of farrowing.
- From 1.1.2013, group housing of sows compulsory in all EU pig holdings with 10 sows or more
- Group housing of sows already a EU requirement in new pig holdings since 1.1.2003 in EU-15 MS and date of accession in EU-12 MS.
- Derogation to group housing of sows for holdings with fewer than 10 sows



Implementation of group housing of sows

- ➤ MS are primarily responsible for the implementation
- ➤ Obligations of MS under Regulation (EC) No 882/2004 on official controls
- controls on welfare in farms on a risk basis (Art 3)
- actions in case of non compliance (Art 54)
- sanctions effective, proportionate and dissuasive applicable in case of infringements to animal welfare rules (Art 55)
- Commission as guardian of the Treaties shall ensure that MS apply EU welfare legislation



Implementation plan of the Commission for 2012

- Collection of data and national action plans from the MS
- Increasing communication on the issue
- Training of official veterinarians
- Audits of the Food and Veterinary office
- Preparatory work in order to be ready to launch infringement procedures against non compliant Member States as from 1.1.2013
- Letter from Commissioner Dalli to ministers of agricuture
- Task force DG AGRI/DG SANCO: financial support Rural Development Programmes and internal market issues



State of implementation (1)

- Estimations on 12.4.2012 on the basis of the data sent by the Member States
- 15 MS estimate they will fully comply by 31.12.2012
- 5 MS at least 90% compliant holdings by 31.12.2012
- 4 MS 70% to 89% compliant holdings by 31.12.2012
- 3 MS no previsions for 31.12.2012 and current level of compliance ranges from 28% to 65-70% compliant holdings
- Progress made by MS towards compliance since the Commission started collecting data



State of implementation (2)

- Main category of estimated non compliant holdings are holdings with a capacity of 10-99 sows
- Significant efforts needed to reach compliance for some of the MS which are major EU producers

- Unfair competition
- No mandatory labelling for pig farming systems
- Concerns about potential drop in pig production
- Imports from Third Countries

- Financial support through rural development programmes
- Cross compliance
- Sanctions to be taken by MS in case of non compliance
- Infringement procedures
