Ongoing discussions on the EU "Quality Package"

- **Publication of legislative proposals (**10 December 2010)
- ✓ No legal provisions dedicated to « local farming and direct sales »
- ✓ « <u>further study and analysis will be carried out</u> to assess the problems faced by small-scale producers in participating in Union quality schemes.
- COMAGRI vote on 21 June 2011
- ✓ The Commission, <u>by 30 September 2012 shall produce a report</u> on the case for a new local-farming and direct sales labelling scheme
- ✓ This report, if necessary, will be accompanied by appropriate legislative proposals.
- Ongoing "trialogue" discussions



Ongoing discussions on the EU "Quality Package"

- A Working Group on "<u>EU labelling for local farming and direct sales</u>" was created in October 2011 as <u>sub-group of the Advisory Group on « quality »</u>
- **3 meetings of this Working group** have been organized so far
- √ 10 November 2011
- ✓ 27 January 2012
- √ 15 March 2012



Findings of the Working Group on "product from my farm" (March 2012)

a) "Product from my farm » - a need for a definition?

- ✓ Raw materials, feedstuffs, ingredients.
- ✓ Traceability of the product back to the farmer.
- ✓ Processing of products on or away from the farm?

b) Making "product from my farm" visible to consumers

- ✓ Add value to a product from a farm through a product label
- ✓ Impact of a product label on communication with consumers.

c) Marketing opportunities for "product from my farm":

- ✓ direct sales
- ✓ short marketing chains (distance, intermediaries)
- ✓ public procurement (local schools, etc.),

d) Making "product from my farm" credible:

- ✓ what control mechanisms
- ✓ how to perform controls without unnecessary costs and administrative burden

Proposed outline and architecture of a new system

- 1. Distinction between "local sales networks« / "direct sales" and "short supply chain sales"
- **2.** Proposal for creating of a **common definition at EU** level :
- ✓ <u>e.g.</u>: creating an <u>optional quality term</u> (rather than a certification system)
- ✓ A posteriori control at national level by means of official inspections

Proposed outline and architecture of a new system

- 3. <u>Member States have the choice</u> as to whether or not to implement it nationally.
- **4.** <u>European logo</u>: this issue could be **addressed subsequently**, once these concepts and provisions are clearly defined.

- "Creating a common framework for identifying initiatives for selling their products through local markets or short supply chain networks could potentially help"

But [...]

- "The issue of short supply chains and local sales must <u>not</u> be reduced to the creation of an EU value-enhancing <u>product claim</u>"
- ✓ extending current measures under article 32 of Regulation 1698/2005 – Rural Development Policy
- ✓ Efforts in terms of promotion

Proposals on the future of the CAP

Indicative list of rural development measures for small farms and short supply chains

- Investment and local infrastructure: on farm investment in physical assets, basic services and village renewal.
- **Farm and business development:** Business start up aid for young farmers, non-agricultural activities in rural areas and development of small farms, investments in non-agricultural activities, Annual payment for "small farmers" transferring their holding.
- **Skills and concept development, quality promotion**: knowledge transfer and information actions, advisory services, farm management and farm relief services, quality schemes for agricultural products and foodstuffs.
- Cooperation of different partners: small operators sharing facilities and resources, promotion activities related to short supply chains and local markets, setting up producer groups.
- Local strategies (Leader)



Proposals on the future of the CAP

Thematic sub-programmes (TS)

Member States may include within their rural development **programmes thematic sub-programmes**, contributing to the Union priorities for rural development.

These are aimed to address specific needs identified, among others in relation to

small farms;

short supply chains
