### Surveillance, eradication programmes, disease freedom

- Delegated act on surveillance, eradication programme and disease freedom
  - General rules / articles are largely finalised
  - Currently working on disease specific provisions:
    - tuberculosis, brucellosis, Aujeszky's, EBL, IBR/IPV, BVD, bluetongue, AI, NCD, aquatic diseases,...
    - work on remaining diagnostic methods
- Consultation on the draft ongoing, expected to be completed in December 2018





#### Disease control measures

- Delegated act on disease control measures
  - Mainly <u>Cat. A diseases</u>, but also <u>some rules for cat.</u>
     B and C diseases
  - Rules for diseases such as
    - classical and African swine fever, foot-and-mouth, avian influenza, lumpy skin disease etc.,
    - "Exotic" aquatic diseases
- Consultation on the draft ongoing, expected to be completed in December 2018





### Establishments: registration and approval, record keeping, I&R rules

- 1. Delegated act on registration and approval of establishments, record keeping, registers animal identification and registration
- For terrestrial animals and different establishments:
  - ungulates, poultry, captive birds, bees, dogs& cats, etc.
  - E.g. poultry establishments, assembly operations, confined establishment, quarantine
- Consultation in the expert group completed
  - Soon available for public feedback (Dec 2018)
- 2. Implementing act(s) on animal identification
  - (1) All species apart from equidae, and (2) equidae
  - Ongoing consultation on act under (1)



#### **Movements of terrestrial animals**

- Delegated act on movements of terrestrial animals (and products of animal origin)
  - Focussing on the rules for movement of:
    - Ungulates (incl. equidae), poultry, captive birds, bees, dogs&cats, non-human primates, circuses, movements through confined establishments, etc.
      - Link with rules for eradication programmes, disease freedom
- Consultation in the expert group ongoing expected to be completed in November 2018





#### **Germinal products**

- Delegated act on approval and registration of establishments, traceability and movements of germinal products
- Rules for AI centres, embryo collection, "trade" with semen ova embryos
  - Traditional, but also some less traditional species
- Consultation in the EG completed
  - soon available for public feedback (December 2018)
- 2. Implementing act establishments, traceability (marking), certificates
  - consultation in the WG completed
  - soon for public feedback (Dec 2018)



## Aquatic animals – establishments approval registration and movements

- Delegated act on approval and registration of establishments
- Delegated act on movements of aquatic and aquaculture animals



#### **Entry into EU**

- Delegated act on entry into EU
  - Animal health requirements for:
    - Animals (terrestrial and aquatic)
    - germinal products and
    - products of animal origin

N.B. Not to be confused with the official controls at the borders

- Consultation in expert group ongoing, but...
  - Draft almost finalised
  - Awaiting for other acts: fine-tuning of diseasespecific rules





#### Adoption, timeline and meetings

- Focus on the adoption of key (priority) DAs deadline April 2019
- Non-priority acts to be developed 2019-2020
- Link and coordination needed with the official controls regulation (OCR)
- Meetings, consultation:
  - on some acts expert and working groups completed, others ongoing
- Meeting of Animal Health Advisory Committee : 3
   December 2018
