Russian embargo impact on the Latvian dairy sector

- In comparison to July, 2014 the prices of milk purchase have decreased with 25%. At the moment milk producers receive from 0,12 to 0,255 EUR for 1 kilo of milk. Already in August the prices of milk purchase have decreased below production cost.
- There are reserves of the products in the milk production. Dairy production enterprises cannot pay to farmers in time, as well as they cannot provide appropriate price of milk purchase.









Russian embargo impact on the Latvian fruit and vegetable sector

- Depending from the product, in average the price in vegetable sector has decreased for 30%-50%.
- Approximately 30-40% of all vegetable areas are not going to be harvested.
- Vegetable producers are directly affected by the rapid growth of market supply and essential increase of the production import of other countries.





Russian embargo impact on Latvian pig industry

- The prices have decreased by 18% since July.
- Pig-breeders work below production cost since September.
- Slaughterhouses purchase pigs in live weight for only 1.00 EUR per kilo.
















Additional problem for pig sector

African swine fever

- There was discovered African swine fever on the border of Belarus and Latvia on 26th June, this year.
- Sanitary zone ~ half of country territory
