






## ...and the EU's agricultural footprint




+Ammonia emissions from agriculture

### **Essence of the Farm to Fork Strategy**

- Farm to Fork Strategy in **spring 2020** 
  - Document to provide **direction**
  - With a list of **actions** for the next 5 years
  - Overall objective: **sustainable food system** in environmental, social and economic terms

• Covering **all stages** in food supply chain

## Of particular interest to the farm sector...

- "Increased level of ambition" in cutting the use of chemical pesticides, fertilisers and antibiotics
- **Stakeholder dialogue** to help identify means of achieving this (including legislative means)
- Use of "sustainable practices" to rise including **organic farming**
- **CAP strategic plans** must **fully reflect these ambitions** and other elements of the Green Deal

#### Green Deal implies Future CAP must focus on:

#### • Strategic plans ...

... which, based on SWOT analysis, link national (climate) strategies to CAP policy measures

### • Significant reduction in input use ...

... need to be reflected in CAP plans with respect to fertilisers, pesticides and antibiotics

#### • Boosting organic production ...

... with measures that ensure a balanced growth of both supply and demand



## A key role for stakeholders

Transition to sustainable food systems needs all actors along the food chain to engage and co-create effective policies

#### We want the process to be:
